SUBJECT: FY2019 Housing and Dining Rates

PROPOSED: That the Board of Regents approve the recommended FY2019 Housing and Dining Rates.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION: The Housing and Dining System is a self-sustaining auxiliary unit which requires establishing room and board rates that are sufficient to meet bond covenants and support the University's strategic goals.

The Housing and Dining Advisory Board meets throughout the Fall semester to review current operations and discuss any operational changes anticipated for next year. Consideration for any new rate recommendations will be fully vetted by the Advisory Board and will be presented at the March Board of Regents meeting. The new rates would begin with the start of Fall semester 2018.

The Advisory Board is comprised of student representatives from the Resident Hall Association (RHA), Associated Students of Washington State University (ASWSU), Graduate and Professional Students Association (GPSA), as well as representatives from the Budget Office, Finance & Administration, and Student Affairs.
