WSU Pullman, Public Safety Building - Schematic Design (Olivia Yang)

SUBJECT: WSU Pullman, Public Safety Building, Schematic Design

PROPOSED: That the Board of Regents approve the schematic design for the WSU Pullman Public Safety Building project.

**SUPPORTING
INFORMATION:**

The WSU Police Department currently occupies the Public Safety Building located in the center of campus. The building is aging and does not support unobstructed vehicular access to and from the building, necessary for efficient police response. During most of the daytime hours, the area around the Public Safety Building fills with pedestrian traffic heading to central campus destinations, and service vehicles crowd the surrounding roadways. The current location is adjacent to Martin Stadium making access very difficult during home football game weekends. Furthermore, the building is nearly 50 years old and its mechanical and electrical systems are at the end of their useful life.

A new building for the WSU Police will provide effective vehicular access to campus and surrounding communities, and support their needs for many years into the future. In addition, the relocation of the WSU Police is a critical first step toward the completion of a new WSU Museum of Art Building, which would be constructed on the existing Public Safety Building site.

The new building will have approximately 15,000 GSF including a 2,500 GSF garage for the police vehicles. The building will include offices, evidence rooms and weapons storage, locker rooms, records storage, a small kitchen and a conference room for training sessions. The site at the corner of Olympia Avenue and Grimes Way provides excellent vehicular access and room for future growth.

The Board of Regents approved the design and construction for the project within the budgeted amount of \$7,500,000 in the September 2014 meeting.
