Academic Year 2014-2015 Tuition Rates

TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS

SUBJECT: Academic Year 2014-2015 Tuition Rates

PROPOSED: That the Washington State University Board of Regents approve a 0% tuition increase to all tuition categories for the academic year 2014-2015.

SUBMITTED BY: Joan King, Associate Vice President and Chief University Budget Officer

SUPPORTING INFORMATION: State law authorizes the governing boards of the four-year institutions of higher education to establish tuition and fees for all students.

A 0% increase in resident undergraduate tuition for the academic year 2014-2015 was approved at the March 28, 2014 Board of Regents meeting. This item covers the remaining tuition categories, which also will not increase for the next academic year.

The 2014-2015 tuition rates are shown below as full-time, annual rates and are the same as those charged for the 2013-2014 academic year.

1. This rate is for the Master of Business programs on the Pullman campus. Students enrolled in the MBA programs at WSU Tri-Cities and WSU Vancouver will continue to pay the regular graduate student tuition rate.
2. Under a memorandum of understanding between WSU and UW, students attending the first year of medical school in Seattle, Pullman or Spokane will pay the same total tuition and enrollment fees. These rates will be set by the University of Washington for the medical school.
